Creative development

Art/DT - We will look at the work of the illustrator Quentin Blake who illustrates many of Roald Dahl's books. Using pen and ink and watercolour, we will turn our sketches into our own amazing illustrations.

Music – This term we will be learning how to sing and perform effectively as an ensemble.

We will be learning to compose using instruments and voices in the style of the composer Alexandre Desplat.

Physical development

In PE this term, we will be learning how to propel and control objects effectively and applying these skills in a variety of outdoor games. PE lessons are on a Monday afternoon and a Thursday morning. A complete named P.E kit should be in school every day.

Communication language and literacy

This term we will be looking at a variety of different books by Roald Dahl. We will be spending time looking at how the author uses descriptive language and how interesting characters are created! We will start by learning 'The Enormous Crocodile'!

Children must read at home twice a week, written evidence should be recorded in their reading record book. School books will be changed on Mondays and Thursdays.

Spellings will be given out on a Friday and tested the following Thursday. Please ensure books are in on time!



Knowledge and understanding of the world

<u>Computing:</u> We will be learning to use a search engine effectively and how to stay safe online.

<u>Science</u>: We will be learning about living things and their habitats, exploring how different living creatures have adapted to live where they do.

<u>RE:</u> We will be looking at what we know about what God is like and why we should care for God's world.

Problem solving, reasoning and <u>numeracy</u>

This term we will be looking at number facts, place value, counting in multiples and ordering numbers. We will then go over quick and more complicated methods for adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

Homework will be sent out based on the unit of work every fortnight on a Friday, starting from Friday 18th September. This is due in the following Friday.
