### Creative Development

Art -We will be developing our collage skills in art, as well as sketching our homes.

**DT** – We will be designing and making houses and shoes using junk modelling, thinking about the inside and outside of our homes.

**Music-** Year I will be exploring pulse & rhythm, focusing on a range of well-known songs and rhymes & some new ones.

## Knowledge and Understanding of the World

**Geography** – We will be investigating the features of the UK. Focusing on the 4 different countries and their capital cities as well as looking at the oceans of the world.

**Computing-** We will be developing our basic knowledge of ICT and create opportunities for the children to use both the computers and iPads independently.

**RE** – Year I will be looking into the questions, 'Who is God?' And 'The Creation Story'.

# Personal and Social Development

This term our topic is 'New Beginnings' focusing on the importance of their transition into Year I. Also we will be looking at ways to develop the children's self-confidence and building upon their abilities.

## Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy

We will be basing our maths around the topic area for the term. From this, we will be looking at number skills, focusing on addition and subtraction. We will also be developing our space, measure and statistics knowledge.

# Communication, Language and Literacy

This term Year I will be looking at two story books - Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Elves and The Shoemaker. These will be used to predominantly enhance our story writing skills. We will spend time role playing, creating story maps and writing our own versions of the stories. We will also write lists, letters and instructions.

### Physical Development

The children will be taking part in a SKiL session on a Friday with Mr Angella developing and exploring movement and Team Building.

This will be reinforced and built upon during a PE session on a Wednesday afternoon with Miss Pope.
