Dear Reception Parents,



Did you know?

#### Reading

The children have made a fantastic start to their phonics and reading. A big thank you for your support in reading at home with your child, it is making a huge difference  $\odot$ . Please make sure you are reading as much as possible with your child and are recording this in their reading record book. We do make a note of this weekly. If your child has not been read with then their book will remain the same.

News from home

We will be introducing more books with words as well as pictures. The children might not recognise every word but can be encouraged to sound out the sounds they do know. This will all come with regular practise.

#### Quick Reminders:

- ✓ Please make sure your child continues to bring in their water bottle, book bag and reading folder every day. <u>Water only in water bottles please</u>, this is school policy.
- ✓ As the weather is becoming colder, please make sure a coat is brought in every day. Gloves and hats may also be brought in too, these can be put into the children's trays.

# Personal, Social & Emotional Development

In PSED we will be continuing to focus on sharing and turn taking with a range of games and activities to demonstrate this. We will also focus on how we can resolve disagreements with our friends sensibly.

In ICT we will be using 2Simple and other programmes to design and draw different types of transport and make maps linked to different journeys.



## Expressive Arts & Design

In Art we will be making our own modes of transport by designing and making these using junk modelling. We will also be exploring how instruments work.

Nearer Christmas we will be doing a wide range of 'Christmassy' activities and crafts to bring home to show you!

#### Communication & Language/Literacy

This term our class topic is 'Are we there yet?' We will be focusing on the different types of transport we can take to go on a range of journeys to both real and imaginative places.

We shall be making passports to take on our 'aeroplane experience' and even post our own written letters home nearer the end of term to leave for Father Christmas. Look out for these in the post!



#### **Mathematics**

In Maths we will be continuing to practice our counting and shape work. We will be linking these to rhymes and songs to help us to remember them.

We shall also use our indoor role play of an airport to help us with our learning of money and direction

#### Physical Development

This term our focus is
Gymnastics and Dance. We shall
be linking these concepts to our
topic exploring different ways
of moving and thinking about
how we can perform confidently
to others. PE will continue to be
on a Monday and Tuesday.

We will also be enjoying a range of fine motor skills activity in our outdoor area to work on our handwriting and pencil grip.



### Understanding the World

This term we will be looking at the different seasons, starting with an Autumn walk, observing the changes we are beginning to see.

We will also be learning about Bonfire Night and how we can be safe when around fireworks.

Later on in the term will be learning about the Christmas Nativity and be working very hard to practise for our Nativity performance!
