Creative Development

DT- We will be designing, making and evaluating our own buildings from 1666 using a range of different materials.

Music - The children will be learning to sing different songs. We will begin by learning London's burning and we will also be adding actions to go alongside our singing.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Science - Year 2 will be looking at different materials. Learning about their uses and different properties.

ICT- We will be starting some work on scratch based on the Fire of London.

RE- Year 2 will be learning about what it means to be Christian.

History - We will be conducting lots of research into the Fire of London and learning where it happens in our past

Communication, Language and Literacy

We will begin by learning about the Gunpowder plot and will write some poetry about it. We will then move onto writing our own diaries about the Fire of London.

We will be having phonics sessions every day, learning how to say, spell and use different sounds.



Physical development

The children will be learning about different ways to move and control the body and then looking at different ways of expressing and exploring movement.

Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy

Year 2 will be continuing our work into understanding number. We will also be looking at measurement, and what the suitable units and equipment would be.

Maths homework is given two fortnightly and time tables is given out weekly. Homework is due in on a Friday. Please make sure the times table folder is in school!

Personal and social development

This term, we will be focusing on keeping healthy, what food we eat and how we keep clean. We will also touch upon bullying and understanding our emotions.
