Creative development

In DT we will be designing and creating our own Anglo-Saxon Jewellery and Shields. These will be based on designs that will have been researched throughout the first few weeks.



Communication language and literacy

In Literacy we will be using the Pie Corbett version of the Anglo-Saxon story of 'Beowulf'. Children to use this as a focus for grammar/ punctuation/ spelling as well as learning about writing 'Folk Legends'.

Problem solving, reasoning and numeracy.

We will be looking at number skills this term, including mental calculations and written methods, and using these to solve a range of problems. We will also be focusing on our understanding of different kinds of numbers and place value.



Knowledge and understanding of the world

In ICT the children will be researching the Anglo-Saxons and creating websites with the information they find. ICT will be taught as part of rotations with Mr. Mackarness.

R.E : We will be focusing where the Bible came from, and its significance in Christians lives.

Science: We will be looking at Properties of Materials - solids liquids and gases, and what happens when we apply changes to them.

History- As our topic is based around the Anglo-Saxons, we will be looking very closely at the lives they led, where they came from, where they settled, their rules and punishments. This topic will be rounded off with a trip to the Weald and Downlands Museum.
