



Dear Reception Parents,

Happy New Year! We hope you had a wonderful Christmas break.



<u>Reading</u>

The children's reading is coming along really well with many children beginning to recognise words from sight. Now that the children are using their sounds to blend new words, it is important that they begin to discuss each book in detail and understand the characters and what is happening in the story. A big thank you for your support in reading at home with your child, it is making a huge difference O. Please make sure you are **writing in your child's reading record diary when they have been read with**.

The children will be read with by an adult 2 times a week. Included in this will be a Guided Reading session where reading is done within a group, daily class phonics sessions and high frequency word practice.

Phonics Books



Phonics books will be <u>collected in on a Thursday</u> with new sounds learnt that week going home on a <u>Friday</u>. These books are designed for the children to practise their phonics either through speaking, writing words or writing sentences. Please encourage your child to look at these as it will help them with their reading.

Quick Reminders:

- ✓ Please make sure a coat is brought in <u>every day</u>.
- ✓ Please make sure water bottles are brought into school every day.
- ✓ Our PE days are <u>Monday and Tuesday</u> but please make sure PE kits remain in school all week in case this is changed.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be continuing our PSED sessions with Mr Crowley thinking about different areas of learning including healthy living and solving problems without always needing an adult.

In ICT we will be practising using the mouse and the keyboard to control games and programs on the computer. We will also be using ICT to inform our phonics learning.

Expressive Arts & Design

In Art/DT we will be designing and making our own dinosaur fossils and dinosaur eggs by carefully following instructions!

We will also be looking at where dinosaurs lived and be thinking about how we can use construction materials to make habitats and dinosaur 'houses'.

Communication & Language/ Literacy

This term our topic is 'Long Long Ago..' with focus on Dinosaurs. We will begin our topic by receiving a special delivery to our classroom! I wonder what could be inside...

This term we will be learning names of some of the dinosaurs, finding out where they existed and how do we know this as well as many other activities in our adult focus time and child initiated learning through play.

In maths we are focusing on being measurement explorers! We will be discovering the size and measurements of dinosaur footprints that arrive in our classroom and be thinking about organising objects in size order. We shall also be taking the measurements of a giant dinosaur and be comparing this to ourselves! As well as this we will begin to look at addition and finding the total of two sets.

Physical Development

This term we will be continuing our SkiL sessions with Mr Angella on a Monday morning based on movement and dance. The skills learnt in this session will be built upon and reinforced in a second session with Miss Lever on a Tuesday. Please make sure PE kits are in school all week.

As we are beginning to become writers, we will be working on our fine motor control through handwriting and small movement activities.

Understanding the World

This term we have a big focus on Dinosaurs! We shall be exploring how we know that dinosaurs existed long long ago and be designing and making our own dinosaur fossils. We will also be looking at parts of a dinosaur, labelling these and thinking about how they are different to our own bodies. As well as this we will be looking at what dinosaurs eat and be linking this to our own healthy eating.
