Facts about the Ark



The Size of the Ark

300 cubits long 50 cubits wide 30 cubits high

A cubit is the length from the elbow to the longest finger

FLOATING FACTS

■ According to Genesis, the Ark was 450ft by 75ft and 45ft high – that is taller than a three-storey building and with a deck area the size of 36 tennis courts.

■ A replica of the Ark is being built at Frostburg, Maryland. Work began 30 years ago.

■ Christians argue that Noah needed 40,000 animals to represent every kind of creature. Sceptics say Noah would have needed room for at least 1.5 million species.

■ The story may be based on an earlier, and very similar, Babylonian flood tale from the Epic of Gilgamesh.

Noah, or Nuh, is one of the main prophets of Islam. In the Koran, his wife is said to drown in the flood.






