Personal, Social & **Emotional Development**

In PSED we will be thinking about things we are good at and things we would like to learn more about. We will also be practicing our turn taking and listening skills during circle time activities and games.

ICT

In ICT we will continue to put the skills we have learnt so far into practice using computer programmes to document our learning so far. We will also make use of the school cameras and use these to take our own photos of things we observe in springtime.

Expressive Arts & Design

This term we will be looking closely at parts of flowers. We will be making our own flower collages using different materials, practicing our sketching skills and also designing our own gardens. We will also be looking at the season of 'Spring' and have already begun turning our 'Reading Garden' into a beautiful blossom treel



Communication & Language/ Literacy

This term our topic is 'Round and Round Whatever Next ..?' where we will be looking at new life, growing and planting and lifecycles. We shall also be experiencing our very first school trip! More information to be given shortly 🙂 In Literacy we will be finding out facts about all these things, writing cress diaries and instructions of how to plant seeds and what they need to grow.

Mathematics

This term we will looking at the concept of time, by completing many fun 1 minute challenges. We shall also be looking at clocks and learning how to tell the time using o'clock. In our 'Garden Centre' role play we will also be exploring money and be looking closely at coins and how much items cost in the shop.

We will be continuing our Monday PE session with Mr Angella where we will be learning lots of new skills. We will also be doing PE outside as the weather starts to get warmer, please make sure you have plimsolls in school.



Understanding the World

Our main focus this term will be plantin, growing and lifecycles. We will be looking at what plants need to grow and be using this knowledge to plant and look after our 'Reception Garden' area. We will also be taking part in a spring walk, observing what we can see in spring time and how this is different from the other seasons.

Our school trip to Plumpton College Farm will also allow us to think about what we have learnt so far and see some of our learning in real life. 😳
