

Expressive Arts and Design

Art/Design - We will be looking at how we can reproduce images of water using different medium and incorporate these different techniques into producing a piece of art

Music- We will be taking part in **Sing It**, which encourages singing in a group, using expression and performing in front of others.

PSED and Religious Education

PSED-This term our focus is on 'Good to Be Me'. We will focus on what is special about us as individuals, and how we manage our feelings.

RE-Our focus this term is on ways Christians celebrate life events and Easter. We will look in depth at the Easter Story and focus on specific aspects of the story such as The Last Supper.

Communication, Language and Literacy

Year 4 will focus on 'Journey to the River Sea by Eva Ibbotson'.

We will be looking at developing our writing skills when producing diary entries as well as newspaper reports. We will continue to use talk for writing to develop their understanding of how we explore different genres, with particular focus on grammar.

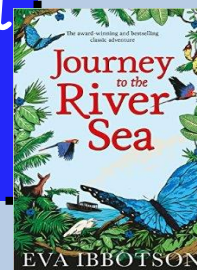
We will use the text to develop our reading, language and comprehension skills during focus Guided Reading sessions each week.
