## Who can stand and vote for parent governors?

You must be the parent of child who is registered to attend St John's Meads and the definition of a parent under education law covers:

All natural parents whether they are married or not

Any person who has parental responsibility for a child or young person

Any person who has care of a child or young person i.e. lives with and looks after the child.
