Communication language and literacy

Science: we will be focussing on our investigation skills this term, carrying out experiments and thinking about how scientists write up experiments for others to learn from.

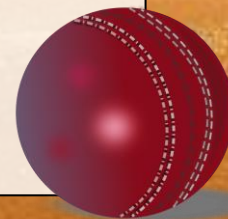
