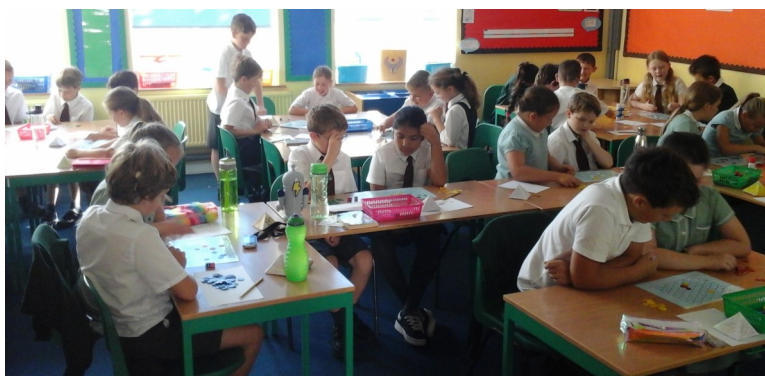

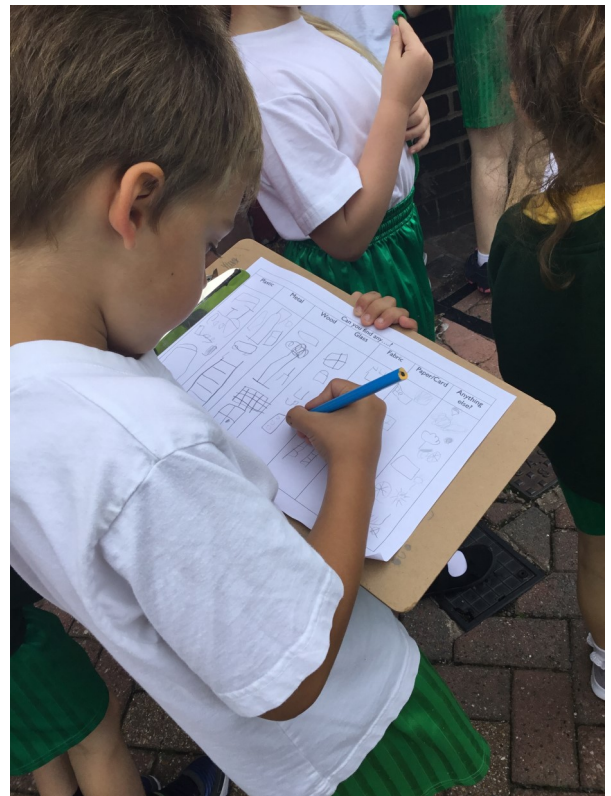


Great to see so many penguins/parents at the Year 1 Teddy Bear Picnic! Hope you enjoyed the time spent with each other and the chance to talk with staff.
