#### Parent Governor Vacancy and Election:

One of our parent governors, Lydia Jourdain, has stepped down from her role. She has been a valued member of the Board of Governors for over two years and her commitment, knowledge and skills have been much appreciated.

Volunteering as a school governor is a worthwhile and rewarding role; giving something back to support education in our community. Governors use skills they have acquired in their personal lives or professional careers and put them to good use. As a governor you will also have the opportunity to:

- improve your work skills
- $\cdot \,$  receive valuable training
- $\cdot\,$  gain experience of managing an educational organisation
- $\cdot\,$  raise questions, discuss issues and help make decisions

No previous experience of being a school governor is required as there is induction training and ongoing support.

All parents\* or carers of registered pupils at the school at the time of a parent governor election are eligible to become parent governors, unless they are: An elected member of the local authority or paid to work in the school for more than 500 hours in any consecutive 12 month period (at the time of election or appointment).

# The Big Anti-Bullying Assembly 2020

On Monday morning the whole school took part in <u>The Big Anti-Bullying Assembly 2020</u>, a virtual event broadcast online and organised by The Diana Award, a national children's charity, and Nationwide Building Society.

The event was hosted by Children's TV presenters Mwaka "Mwaksy" Mudenda and Richie Driss alongside Peter Andre, Katie Leung, Twist & Pulse, Ade Adepitan, James McVey, Cel Spellman, Will Poulter, Hacker the Dog, as well as the famous voice of The X Factor's Peter Dixon.

They were able to enjoy a host of celebrity personal stories, messages and special performances as well as offering key information and guidance on how to handle bullying behaviour and the support available.



The children were invited to think of 5 people (one for each finger and thumb) who they would go to if they were worried about bullying; perhaps a family member, a friend or their

teacher, and then asked to 'put their hands up' and pledge to put an end to bullying.
