#### Author Visit News!

On Thursday 3rd February author of the Alfie Jones books, David Fuller, will be visiting all the children in Key Stage 2 to talk about his books and explain what inspires him as a writer. David will also (COVID permitting) deliver a school assembly to all the children. During his sessions, he will discuss memories of his own reading and writing experiences from his school days (he has dyspraxia so found writing fairly difficult; but loved literacy), and his journey to eventually becoming an writer.

He will also talk about his books and explains why (and how) he has decided to write the types of books that he has. There is also an opportunity for the children to get involved in a roleplaying activity, acting out a chapter as David reads it. The last 10 minutes or so of the session are set aside for them to ask him questions. The sessions are designed to be inspirational to all children regardless of their reading and writing ability.
