#### This Week...

This term, we have made some changes to our lunchtime play activities. Now that Ms Laing has returned from maternity leave, we have a focussed play activity each lunchtime. Last week the focus activity was skipping. This week children used the activity tables for games and drawing. Next week we will have the chalks available. The school council will be speaking with their classes about what toys or activities they would like to be purchased for future weeks.

We had a visiting artist (Jenny) in school this week as part of our involvement in The Towner 'Draw me in' Project. She worked with Years 3&4 in the morning, exploring the 'Box of Heads' image provided by the Towner Art Gallery for the Schools Exhibition. They analysed the picture and discussed emotion and direction of gaze. The children made clay heads showing a particular mood or attitude.



In the afternoon, Jenny worked with Years 1&2 discussing the picture and the direction of gaze. The children worked with sticks to transfer their direction of gaze with another child into a pattern on the table. These are in the process of being filled in with colour and pattern.

This work will be ongoing, with all children contributing to an overall school piece on individuality and self-portraiture.
