She has received many awards, been appointed an OBE and DBE, has served as the Children's Laureate and serves as a patron of many charities, including the East Sussex Foster Care Association (ESFCA). Many of Jacqueline's books have been dramatised and adapted for TV, including the well-known stories of Tracy Beaker.






Celebrating Diversity
