Emiko has achieved her Grade 1 Piano and passed with Merit. Congratulations Emiko!



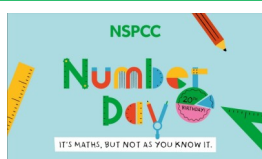

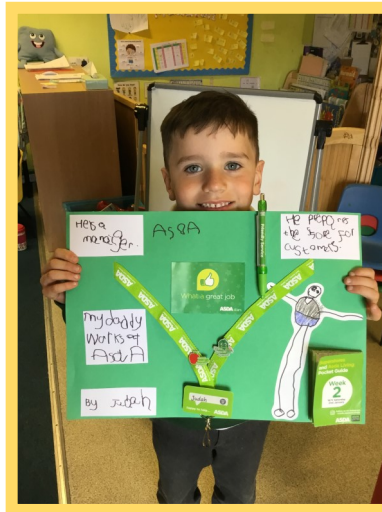
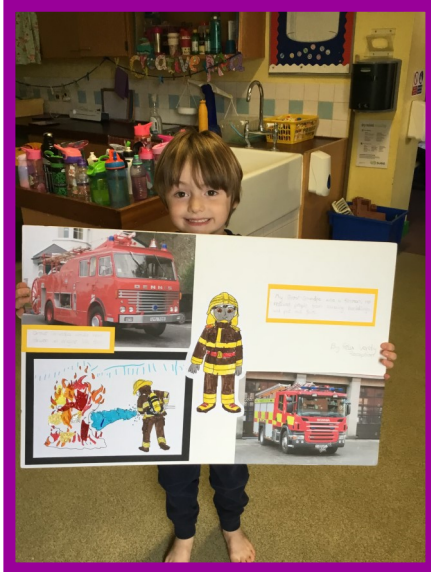
