For the first two weeks of the launch we will use Weduc to send you messages by email and newsfeeds. We will continue to use Parentmail for our booking for Breakfast and Late Birds until 28th May. Weduc will then be operational for Breakfast/Late Birds and for payments and consents for trips and visits (as they come up). Weduc will be fully operational by 7th June.
