




Year 6 have been testing out their Keith Haring sculpture designs using play-doh to check the structure and balance of their planned form.

What a wonderful afternoon down on the field for Forest School! Fantastic activities, fabulously roasted marshmallows and brilliant fun!












School News & Clubs
