Y6 Science Topic

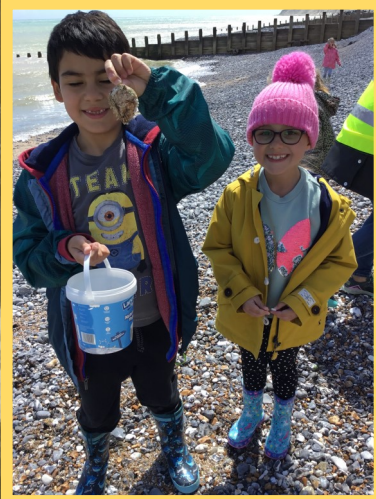


Year 6 exploring were living things and their habitats down on the school field as part of their Y6 Science Day.
