Bikeability Y3 & Y4

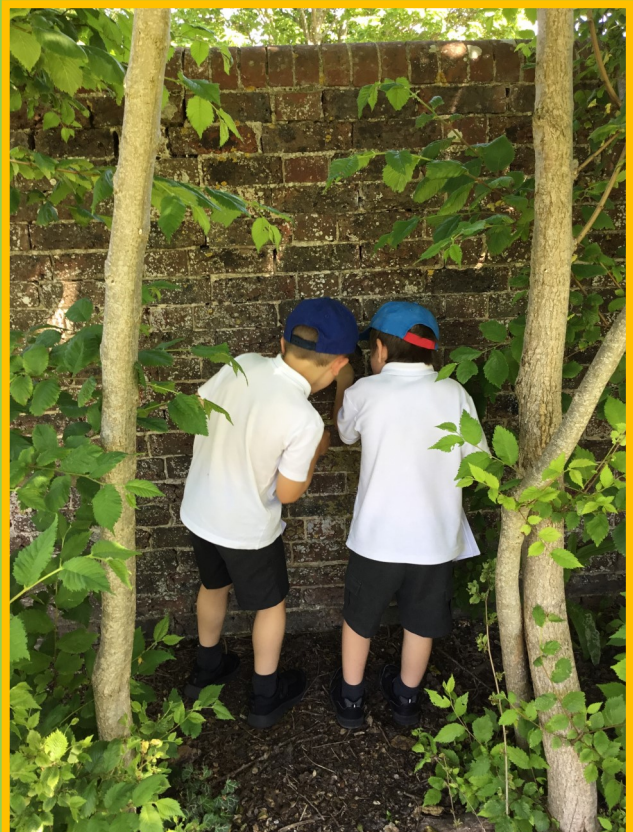
