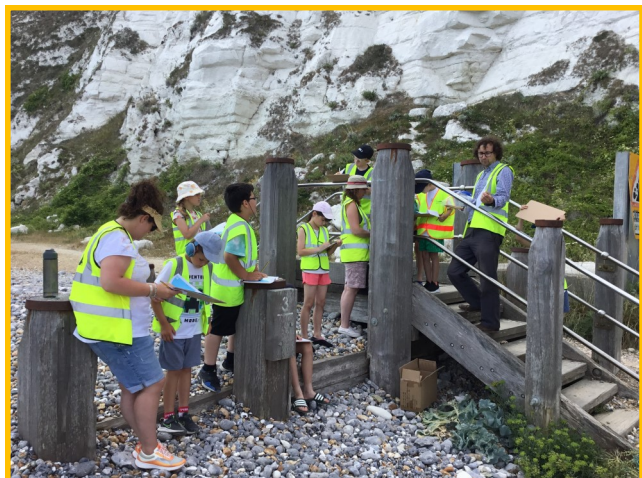
Jonah was awarded 'Most Improved Cub Scout' at his Bushy Wood camp last weekend.
