Finally, some future plans to share about the development of our 'Hub', which is the school's computer room where every class has a weekly 'Computing' lesson. In addition, teachers book extra slots for their class if they want to use computers for cross-curricular work - linking with English or Maths. Children from Years 2-6 also have supervised use of The Hub during first play. The Hub was initially set up with desks and PCs for only 16 children. We have recently purchased additional desks (matching the original colourful jigsaw design) and had cabling installed. **The Friends have now generously agreed to donate £4000 towards the cost of additional computers so that we can continue this project to completion and provide every child with their own workstation in The Hub.
