This week, the children had their first **Pastoral Care** session of the new year. *For those who don't already know, children are vertically grouped (children from Reception to year 6 mix together) in their house teams. Siblings are in the same house and pastoral group. There are two pastoral groups for each house team, so eight in total. These lessons (which take place monthly), are a combination of PSHE and RE based learning, plus worship through prayer and reflection.*
