

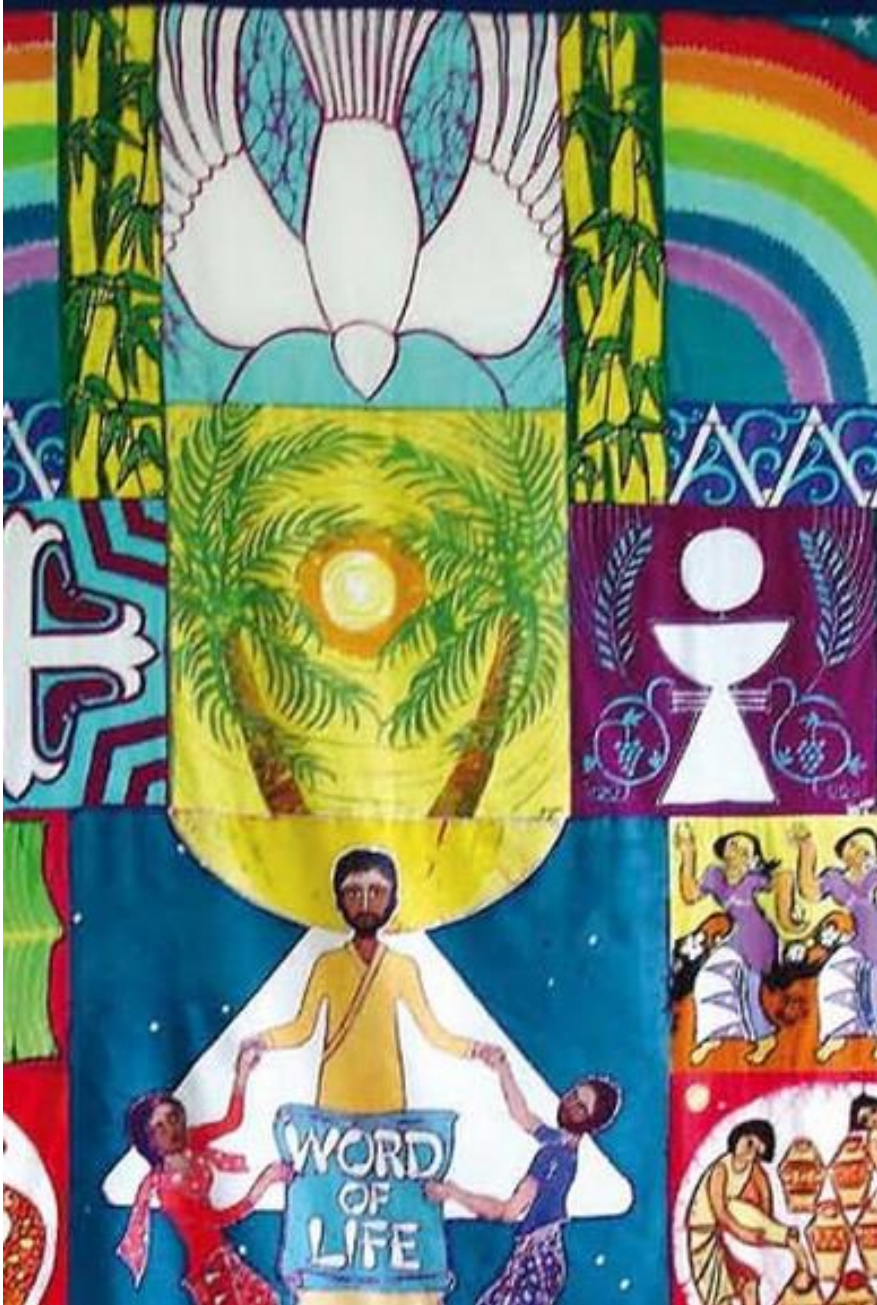

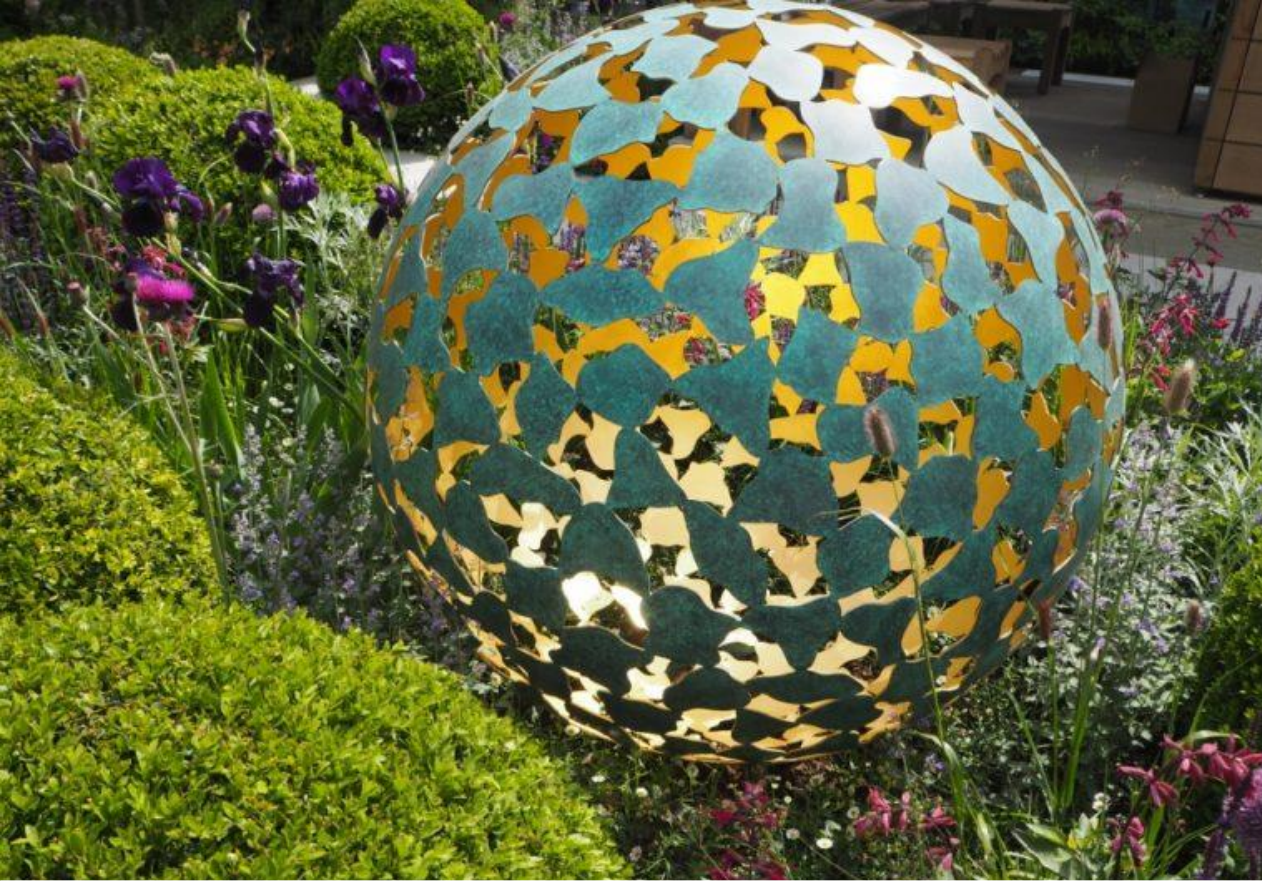

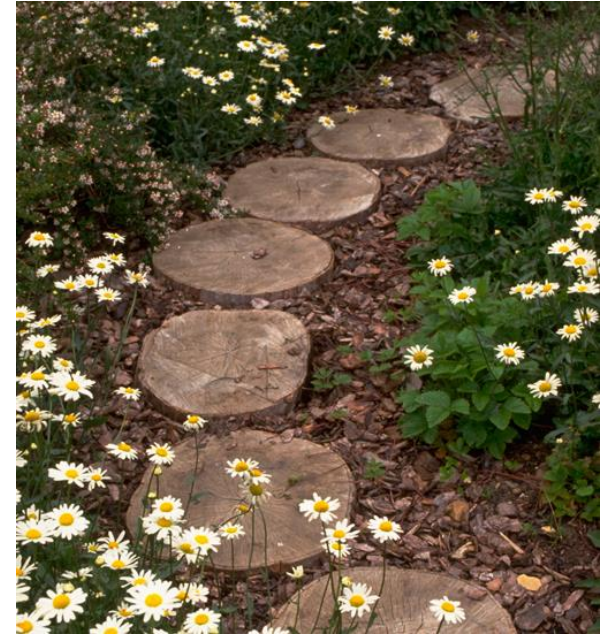
- You will be designing and making models of your special garden and judges will come to look at them. You may be selected for the final competition

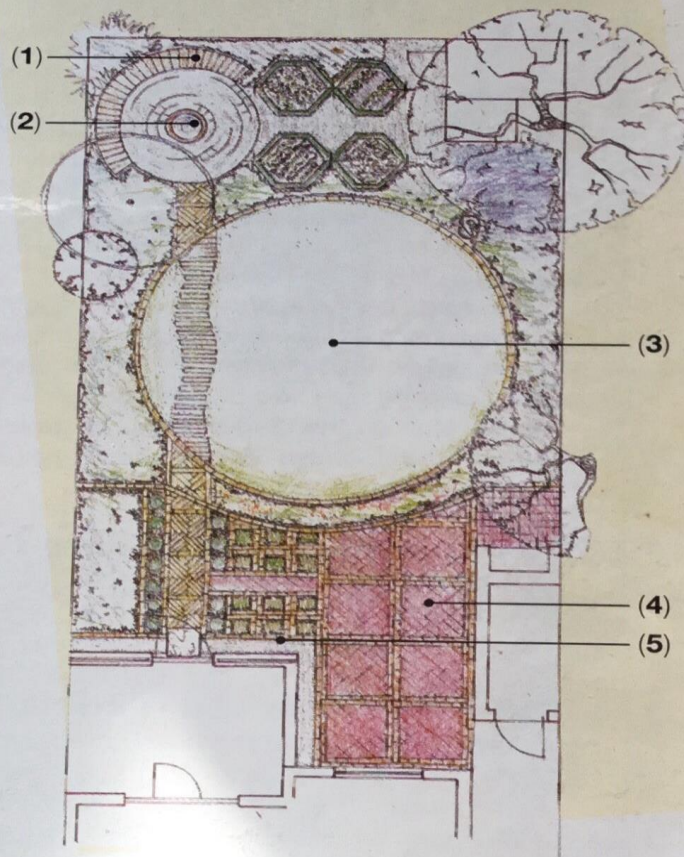

1 *Scabiosa 'Milli Toy'* is an annual available from Mr Fothergill's 01638 552 512

2 *Passion flowers* tumble over the pergola - a romantic summer retreat

3 *Bay trees* have been used to bring winter interest and are great for use in the kitchen

4 *Vibrant purple* *lobelia* add a splash of powerful tumbling colour for summer. Available from most seed catalogues

5 *Clematis 'Jackmanii'* has velvety flowers in mid summer

6 The leaves of *beetroot* add a fresh look to borders and you have a crop in the border - decorative and edible

7 *Creeping scented thyme* is a must for any garden. Plant amongst cracks in paving

8 *Lupins* add height to a border and again add a brilliant purple colour to the garden

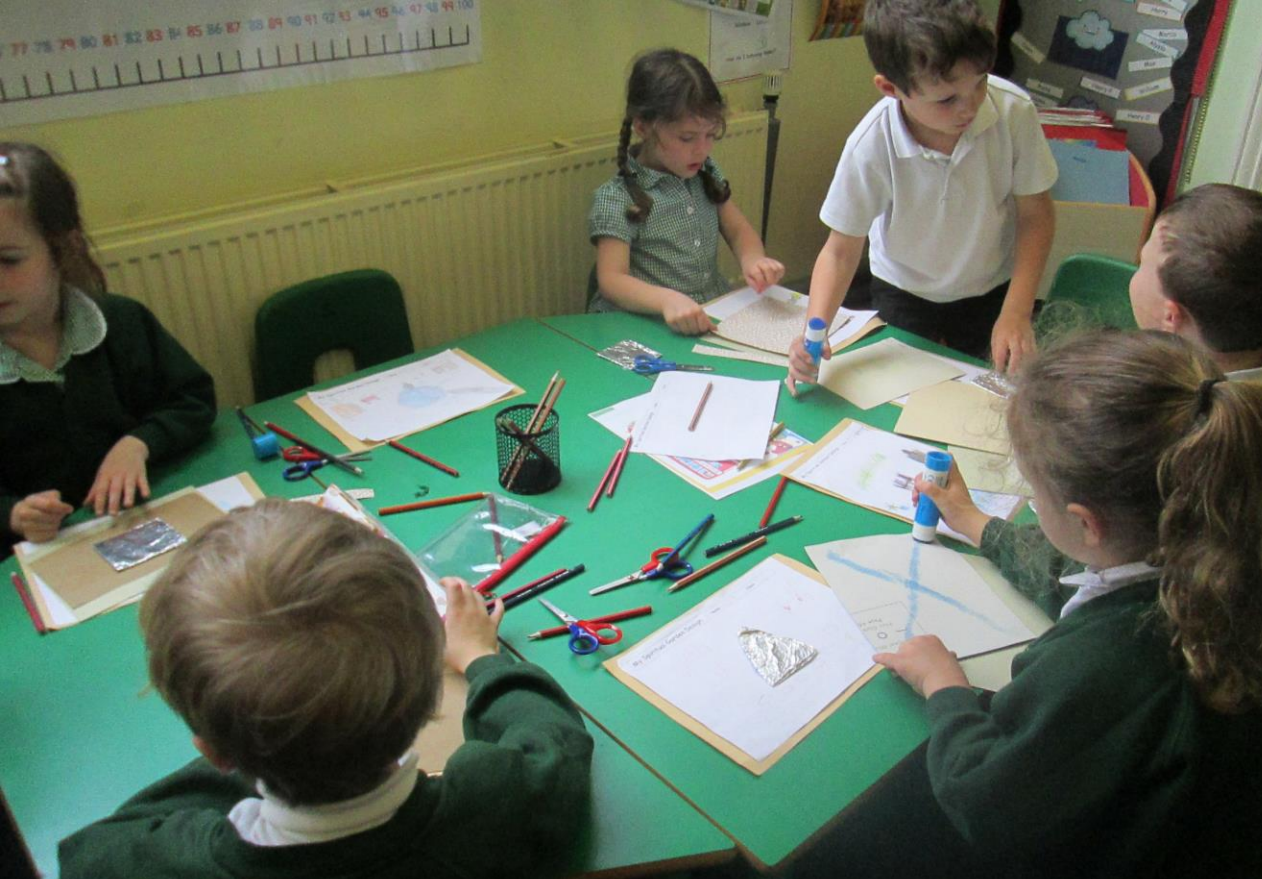
