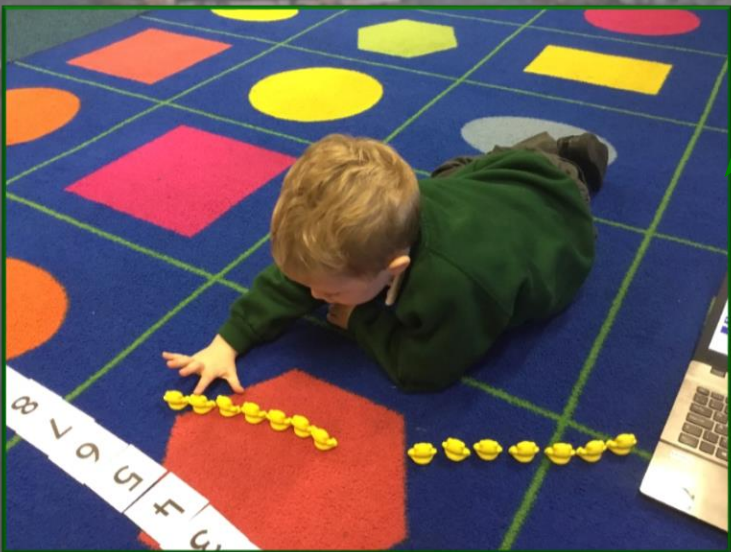
Christian Ethos

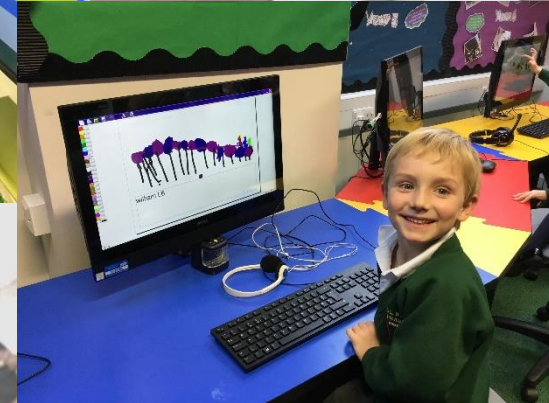
