#### **Out of School Achievements**

Olive Thorpe in Year 5 took part in the UK National Windsurfing championships at the weekend and came second place girl in the Junior 3.5 fleet!

Well done Olive!

Dawson in year 5 also took part in the UK National Windsurfing championships last weekend, stepping up into the 4.5m fleet. Dawson saw off competition from 15 sailors in his fleet, completed all 9 races over two days, winning 8and coming second once! Again Dawson was the youngest competitor in his fleet by at least a year. He was crowned National Champion for the second year running. He has also featured in an RYA article - hot off the press yesterday!

#### Dawson Rogers, the resilient young wave-maker

At just 9 years old, Dawson Rogers is already making waves in the world of windsurfing. His journey began at the age of 6, inspired by watching his dad windsurf and developing a love for the water. Dawson is a member of Buzz Active in Eastbourne, where he learned to windsurf and made strong friendships.

After securing silver at the Techno 293 World Championships, he now dreams of becoming the world's number one windsurfer, representing Great Britain at the Olympics.

"I have got lots more confidence at school and all the time. It's nice to know that I'm doing well with something. I never give up because I know I can work hard and do well"

Dawson has even shared his windsurfing achievements in school assemblies, inspiring other children to join their local club.


#### **Book Lists**
