Concerns about Children or Young People

- If you have any concerns relating to Child Protection or Safeguarding, please contact one of the schools Designated Safeguarding Leads immediately.

Visiting the school?

- If you are a visitor to the school and need to report a concern, please contact the DSL on dsl@sjm.academy or 01323 730255
- If contacting the school is not appropriate, please contact DCAT on 01273 425001 or contact@dcacat.academy

- If a child or other person is at any immediate risk of harm, the first response should always be to call the police on 999. This policy applies to all adults, including volunteers, working in or on behalf of St John's Meads CEP School and DCAT.
