<u>English</u>

We are focusing on stories about 'Bears' starting with Everywhere Bear by Julia Donaldson. We will be retelling the stories, creating story maps and focusing on story openers. We will then look at non-fiction texts and create our very own information writing. We will also be looking closely at our letter formation and the correct use of full stops and capital letters.

<u>Phonics</u>

We will be focusing on digraphs e.g sh, ch, th, ng, ar and short vowel sounds.

<u>Science</u>

We will be exploring the four seasons and explaining ways in which they differ. The children will be identifying ways in which weather can change and how this is impacted in relation to the seasons. We will also be using Autumn as a focus, identifying changes over time and recognising those changes in the world around us.

Creative Arts

We will be exploring music from around the world and will create artwork inspired by Yayoi Kusama .

Forest School

We will be focusing on how to stay safe around the fire and that fire can be used for keeping warm and cooking food. We will also be building shelters and working collaboratively in the outdoor environment.

Religious Education

This term we will be reflecting on the key influences from God and the Creation Story.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will be focusing on New Beginnings', looking at our strengths and how these can make a positive difference to our world and the people around us.

Physical Education

We will be exploring different types of dance and movement, considering how the music can impact our bodies. We will produce sequences of movements to music and consider how they may be performed.

<u>Games</u>

We will be looking at controlling and moving objects and focusing on our throwing and catching skills using a range of resources. We will also consider how we can use different parts of our bodies when playing these games.

Mathematics

Our focus in Maths this term will be Place Value, familiarising ourselves with numbers as digits, words and physical representations. The children will be exploring ways in which we can compare numbers, using mathematical language such as 'Greater than' and 'Less than' as well as representing this using symbols. We will also be exploring ways in which we can order numbers and objects, developing our reasoning and our fluency skills.

Humanities
