Year 3 Term 3 (2024) Curriculum Web

English – This term we will be writing poetry linked to our book 'One Plastic bag' by Isatou Ceesay. We will be writing a character description about a fantasy character with an original personality.

Maths – the main teaching focus this term will be shape and measurement. Weather permitting we hope to get outside for outdoor learning and hone our perimeter skills!

RE – The children are looking forward to learning all about Islam as part of our World Religions study. We will focus on Prophethood and Inspirational people.

PSHE – we will be 'Celebrating Success' and thinking how we can evaluate our own learning process. This should lead to a greater understanding of self and how we overcome challenges to gain success.

Geography – We leave History for a term to learn all about 'Mountains' and will compare a region of the United Kingdom with a region within North America.

Spanish – the theme is' LOS INSTRUMENTOS' and the children will learn to talk about 10 different musical instruments. Any budding musicians will be able to say 'I can play an instrument' and describe it.

Science – A really interesting and important term in Science as we learn about Animals including humans. The overarching theme will be nutrition and how we need a balanced diet to grow and develop.

Music - Music – Mrs White will be teaching the Ocarina which the children are really looking forward to. They will learn what musical notes look like and learn to read simple rhythm notation. This was hugely popular last year and we are certain the children will really enjoy it for 2023/24.

Forest School – This term our school Forest school theme is 'Sowing and Growing' which links perfectly with both PSHE and Science. We will learn more about woodland management and all the important tasks that take place in Spring.

Art – Miss French will continue to teach Art and will be looking at the work of Vincent Van Gough and Claude Delafosse.
