English

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In English this term we are focusing on the lives of famous people. We will be exploring and writing biographies and discovering how these are different from narratives. We will also be exploring Coming to England by Floella Benjamin to develop our own character descriptions, considering both appearance and personality when building our ideas. We will be looking at the structure of stories, identifying the 5 key parts and using these to write our own.

Phonics

We will be focusing on our long vowel sounds and alternative spellings..

Science

This term our focus is Scientists and Inventors. We will be exploring the achievements of significant people and how they have contributed to our lives through their discoveries. We will be looking closely at Mae Jemison and discovering why her achievements are so special. We will also be thinking about the invention of new materials such as plastic.

Creative Arts

We will be exploring portraits and faces, considering how we can create the key features as well as creating our own self portraits in the style of famous artists.

Forest School

We will be focusing on Forest management. We will explore why this is important and we will work collaboratively to maintain and prepare our outdoor spaces ready for spring.

Religious Education

This term we will be exploring Judaism and understanding why the Torah is so significant to the Jewish people. We will also be acknowledging the similarities between the beliefs of Christianity and Judaism.

We will explore our dreams and goals, understanding how it feels when we achieve these and how we can overcome challenges in our paths.

We will be developing our ability to control a ball within a game context, considering how to use tactics and teamwork to achieve our goal.

Gymnastics

We will be practicing balances and how to use equipment safely. We will explore different movements and how we can control our body.

Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of Place Value and Addition and subtraction within 20. We will apply previous learning to greater numbers and build our understanding of the key relationships between numbers and calculations such as the way in which our number bond knowledge can support us when working within 20. We will continue to practice our addition and subtraction as well as working on our fluency and number fact knowledge.

<u>Humanities</u>

This term will be a History focus. We will be focusing on key explorers and their contributions to the modern world. We will also be comparing their experiences and how exploration has changed through history, drawing comparisons between Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong to identify how life has changed.

Computing

We will be focusing on our computer skills, practicing how to turn on, log in and open desktop apps on our computer. We will continue to work on our mouse control and keyboard use as well as our understanding of different icons.

<u>Spanish</u>

We will be learning our numbers to 10 in Spanish as well as some key colours.
