

## English

In English, we will be reading the book *Floodland* by Marcus Sedgwick. We will be exploring the main character of Zoe and how she navigates a world that has flooded. We will be writing character descriptions, poetry and a persuasive speech. This book links nicely to last term's geography work on climate change and this term's work on rivers.

## Spanish

This term the children will be learning what different sports are in Spanish and how to use the verb 'practicar' (to practise) in their sentences.

## Physical Education

In PE, the children will be doing striking and fielding games (cricket and rounders) and athletics to prepare for Sports Day!

## Creative Arts

The topic this term is called 'Take One Picture' and the children will be taking inspiration from the National Gallery. The children will be building on their experience and skills in painting and collage.

In music this term, the children will be learning how to play a 4-hole ocarina this term. This will involve continuing to learn notes on a staff and rhythm notation.

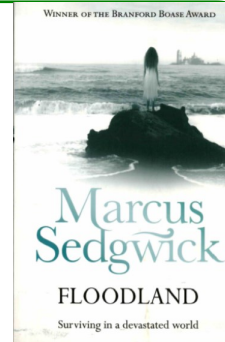
## Religious Education

This term in RE the children are learning about the importance of the Gospels in Christians' lives. They will be reading the Sermon on the Mount, and the Wise and Foolish builders.

## PSHE

Our topic this term is called 'Changing Me'. We will be thinking about puberty and how babies are made. We will also spend some time looking ahead to next year and what we are looking forward to and any changes we might be a bit worried about and what we can do to help alleviate our worries and prepare ourselves for Year 6.

## Humanities

In Geography, we will start by looking at the water cycle and learning why this is such an important process for our planet. We will then be studying rivers and how they erode, transport and deposit materials. We will have a look at river pollution and link this to our previous learning about climate change. We will visit the Cuckmere River to practise some of our practical geography fieldwork skills!

## Mathematics

In Maths this term, we will be finishing off our work on fractions, decimals and percentages with a focus on adding and subtracting decimals as well as multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000 using decimals.

We will then complete a unit on area and perimeter and have a look at measuring and converting units of measurement. Our final topic of the year is volume. This term, the children will complete assessments on everything they have learnt in Year 5 and we will use any remaining lessons to go over some of the more tricky concepts.

## Science

In science, we will be learning about properties and changes of materials. We will look at the water cycle with a focus on evaporation and condensation. We will be investigating which changes are reversible and which are irreversible and use this knowledge to work out which materials will dissolve in a liquid and how to recover a substance from a solution.

## Computing

In Computing this term, the children will be learning to create and adapt sequences of instructions using a program called Flowol. This continues from our work on flowcharts in term 5.
