I can feel the setting sun drizzle over my neck I can feel a warm loving hand, And the bushes brush against my face


Two things you can smell

Dear parents

It has been another busy week, and the children and staff at SJM continue to impress me. It has also been lovely to get some of your feedback from my communication last week and the letter I wrote to the parents of Year 6 regarding my expectations around behaviour. Thank you.

Year 2 school trip to Wakehurst: To my surprise I was on a school trip with the Year 2 children as their teacher was unwell on the day. It was such a worthwhile experience and thank you Mrs Dyer for arranging it. Mrs Gallini and Miss Vile ran everything like clockwork, and we were grateful for the parents who supported and got involved as well. 


