

English

In English this term we will be exploring texts about Tigers and we will create our own narratives and poetry based on these incredible creatures. We will also be looking at healthy eating and will create an information text to help people make healthy choices with their food.

Phonics

As we move towards our phonics screen we will be recapping all of the sounds we have learnt so far, with a particular focus on identifying split digraphs in multi-sound words.

Science

Our focus this term is Plants. We will identify the key parts of a plant and explore what conditions they need to grow. We will explore the world around us and begin to identify different plants, describing their appearance and features. We will also look closely at the lifecycle of plants.

Creative Arts

Art- We will be exploring the work of Klimt and we will refine our Art vocabulary by naming and using different styles and resources. We will use patterns and a range of techniques to create our own pieces.

Music- We will be learning about Tempo and how we can use our voices to create different sounds, songs and chants.

Forest School

We will be focusing on identifying plants and animals this term. We will also be learning how to tie knots using rope.

Religious Education

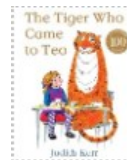

Athletics

We will continue to work on our speed, power and technique when running, jumping and throwing.

Swimming/ OAA

We will continue with our swimming lessons and will then focus on Orienteering and outdoor activities, using directions and map reading skills to complete challenges.

Mathematics

This term we will explore a variety of Maths concepts. We will begin by learning about direction and how we can describe movements of objects. We will then explore numbers up to 100, focusing on counting and identifying patterns and relationships between numbers. We will finish the term by exploring Money and Time, and applying our knowledge to the real world around us.

Humanities

This term will be a Geography focus– we will be looking closely at our local area of Eastbourne. We will compare our coastline to different areas of the world and identify the difference between Human and Physical features in the world around us. We will explore maps, using compass directions to build our own maps and follow directions.

Computing

This term we will be focusing on programming and coding using the program Scratch Jnr. We will learn how to create algorithms and debug them to enable them to work smoothly.

We will be learning all about the sea in Spanish this term. We will learn the names of sea creatures and practice using these in full sentences.
