This week at St. John's Meads

We are one month in and the children at St John's Meads have certainly overwhelmed me with their kindness after my recent bereavement. It has been a lovely distraction, but I had to laugh when some children thought that they needed to offer me their condolences daily. Fortunately, we have moved on from that now. Thank you again for your kindness as well.

The Harvest service was beautiful, the children sang beautifully and our new children in reception did incredibly well in their first service. Thank you for your generosity, it was so very appreciated by the Food bank as well.

In the classroom - I have seen a real step up with the quality of work Year 5 & 6 are producing. Year 4 have been excellent with their comprehension skills and more recently the use of punctuation in dialogue. Year 3 are working well on their editing skills and becoming more independent too.

I have seen some great effort with Year 2's phonics and adding up, and in Year 1 there was lots of great work going on in the recent Geography lesson. I was truly impressed with their knowledge and understanding of which countries make up the United Kingdom prior to being taught about it!

Reception children have settled in well and I could not be prouder of how kind the rest of the school have been towards them. During breaks and lunches, they are never alone, and they seem to know so many names already. They have been practicing their sounds with Little Wandle and already know the difference between graphemes and phonemes. I must admit I do have to plan to spend more time when I visit their class as it is such a joy to watch them learning and be a part of the fun.

<u>Little Wandle and Phonics</u>

I have been so impressed with the work of the staff in Year 1 and Year 2 involved in the teaching and intervention groups of Little Wandle. All staff have been on it with their training and getting things off the ground with a new way of teaching phonics; this included early assessments that were carried out so that every child could have support pitched at their level.

The children are thoroughly enjoying it too and it is amazing to see how quickly they are developing their confidence. The children in Reception are due to start later this month, after their parent workshop.


