Parental Childcare Sufficiency Survey

The Childcare Sufficiency Duty report is a legal requirement.

It outlines how East Sussex County Council (the Council) plans to secure enough childcare places as far as is reasonably practicable, for parents and carers who are working, studying, or training for employment.

The report covers childcare for children from birth to 14 (or up to 18 for disabled children). The feedback from parents and carers will help East Sussex County Council to form the 2025 Childcare Sufficiency Duty Report. The survey can be completed by clicking the link below and you will need to submit your responses by the 7th October.



Save Herstmonceux Observatory & Science Centre

A well-loved, local science education resource and popular destination for school visits is likely to close.

This local education charity has promoted and supported science in the community for nearly 30 years.

The Grade II* listed building and telescopes, former home of the Royal Greenwich Observatory at Herstmonceux, East Sussex are at risk. The Canadian landlords, Queen's University, are not renewing the Science Centre's lease, so come the end of the 2026 season the Science Centre will be homeless.
