

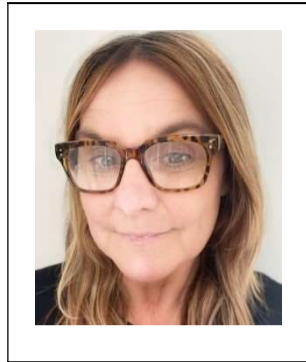

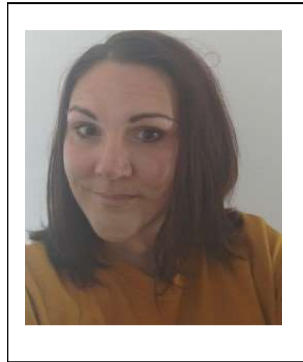

Concerns about Children or Young People

- If you have any concerns relating to Child Protection or Safeguarding, please contact one of the schools designated officers immediately.

Visiting the school?

- If you are a visitor to the school and need to report a concern, please contact the DSL on 01323 730 255 or DSL@sjm.academy
- If a child or other person is at any immediate risk of harm, the first response should always be to call the police on 999. This policy applies to all adults, including volunteers, working in or on behalf of St Johns Meads Primary School and the DCAT.
