
Anxiety and Worry: What it is and how to support your child.


In this session, we will share information about children's mental health and wellbeing and ideas for supporting them.

In Maths we have been partitioning numbers to 50 into tens and ones. We have been writing number sentences to show this.




Number Day activities -Place value bingo and Snakes and Ladders .










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Information Advice Support



For families with children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities

in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex

Amaze is for any family in Brighton & Hove or East Sussex that includes a child or young person with a special educational need or disability aged 0-25. Your child does not need to have a diagnosis to get support.

Workshops & courses

Help with claiming disability benefits

If you want to make a claim for Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payment (PIP) for a child or young person, Amaze can offer free advice and sometimes practical support, if you have extra challenges.

Parent groups & befriending

We offer befriending and regular social groups for parent carers at various locations in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex. Our parent groups are delivered as a partnership with East Sussex Parent Carer Forum (ESPCF) and Brighton & Hove Parent Carers' Council (PaCC).

Support & social groups for young people

Young people aged 14 to 25 with SEND can join our Amazing Futures peer support activity groups in Brighton & Hove, Bexhill, Hastings, Eastbourne and Seaford. Activities include board games, arts and crafts, sports, walks, retro gaming and more.

We also offer careers guidance for young people aged 14 to 25 with SEND in Brighton & Hove, to help them plan their next steps in education, employment or training.





ND Family Support

Our ND Family Support Service is for families with children and young people under 25, before and after assessment for neurodevelopmental (ND) differences such as autism, ADHD and tics/Tourettes. We support families in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex.

We offer family training and navigation, parent groups and befriending, and youth activities for young people with neuro-differences. https://amazesussex.org.uk/nd-family-support

Compass leisure card
