## School Uniform Policy

Wearing school uniform is important in maintaining high standards and a sense of pride and belonging to the school. There is a formal school uniform, which all children are expected to wear, and the co-operation of parents in maintaining the standard of dress is expected.

The majority of our school uniform can be purchased from supermarkets. Items of uniform with the school logo are only available from our uniform supplier - Price and Buckland.

Whilst there are a number of optional items with a school logo, **the only compulsory item with a logo is a bottle green school sweatshirt/cardigan.**

*Previously owned sweatshirts and cardigans may be available from the school office for a small donation.*

**School ties, which are compulsory in years 3-6, are only available from the school office, purchased through Arbor.**

Please make sure **all** items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's name – including shoes.

<b>Summer Uniform</b>  - optional, after Easter holidays until October half term	<u>All children</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Green and white gingham dress/skirt/shorts with white polo shirt and white socks</li><li>• Dark grey shorts/trousers with white polo shirt and grey or black socks</li></ul>
<b>P.E.</b> All Years		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• White round neck PE T-shirt (with optional school logo) or coloured house team t-shirt (optional – available through the PTA 'The Friends')</li><li>• Emerald green PE shorts</li><li>• Navy sweatshirt (with optional logo) and plain navy tracksuit bottoms (no branding/sport logos etc permitted.)</li><li>• White socks and Trainers</li></ul>



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<b>Jewellery</b>	Only wristwatches (not smartwatches) and small, plain studs are permitted
<b>Hair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hair longer than jaw length should be tied back (this applies to both genders)</li><li>• Scrunchies or ribbons should be school colours only (navy, bottle green or white)</li><li>• Alice bands should be school colours only and be an appropriate size</li></ul>
<b>Nail Varnish and Makeup</b>	Nail varnish and make-up are not permitted in school

<b>Additional items</b>	<p><b>Required in school daily:</b> A bag to carry a reading book (school book bag with logo optional) <u>A water bottle</u></p> <p>When needed during the year: A waterproof coat A sunhat Forest school clothing - lightweight old clothing with long sleeves and legs, old trainers or boots Swimming kit, including hat A lunch box</p>
