I was really heartened by the supportive attitude of the Parents/Carers who attended the meetings. Their ideas and their proactive approach was most welcome and I will be communicating with them about this a bit more over the next few months as well.

#### **No Electronic Toys**


No electronic toys are allowed to be brought in to school please.


# Highlights from Year 2

In Year 2 we have been using our timetables to help us solve division problems. We worked in small groups and independently to divide by 2, 5 and 10.










In English we have started writing Amazon Rainforest poems using rhyming words.


